Safety Protocols for 2022 - 2023

As restrictions continue to lift, Infinite Creations will continue to modify and our protocols so that they are reflecting industry best practices and any AHS recommendations. With the provincial and municipal removal of mandatory masking, we encourage dancers and families to make the choice that best suits their families preferences and risk thresholds. All dancers will be supported in their decision to wear masks at IC or not. Hand washing upon entry, frequent use of hand sanitizer, and respecting space between one another is still strongly recommended.


A Note To Our Dancers

The first step in becoming a successful dancer is making a solid commitment to your classes. It is our goal, to instil the proper technique and foundations in your training; however, it is up to you to practice and work hard in each and every class. We also ask that you show your teachers and peers respect at all times.

A Note For The Parents

We appreciate the time and effort you put into to having your child enrolled in our program! We know that children's success depends on the support of their parents/guardians, and because your commitment to the process makes a big difference, we encourage you to be a part of your child's dance education.

Our programs strive on a positive atmosphere and education experience for our faculty, students, and the parents. Cooperation between all parents is expected at Infinite Creations and this means that respect is to be shown to all other parents, students and faculty members. Mutual respect among our faculty and parents provides children with the ultimate care and dance education.



Your child's presence in their dance classes is imperative. While we understand that they will miss class from time to time, we encourage the spirit of teamwork, and the lesson of dedication is a big part of our educational process. **As a parent, your emotional support is highly valued. We ask that you encourage your child to be the best that he or she can be, regardless of what others may achieve.** Dance is an individual art form and children need to be able to achieve at a pace that is comfortable for them. No two students will progress at the same rate, even when they experience the exact same training. We cannot stress enough, how important it is to encourage children to focus on themselves, set their own goals, give their all, and be satisfied with their own accomplishments.

Class Placements

The team at Infinite Creations meet regularly to discuss our student's progress and/or placement. It is our policy, to offer appropriate opportunities to every child. Placement decisions are derived from many years of teaching experience. We believe that children should be placed in a class where they can be confident in order to promote positive self esteem. Placements are highly individual and the factors that go into our placement decisions are complex. Our goal is to ensure that every child receives the best possible training both physically and mentally. We ask that you respect our faculty's professional opinion regarding placement. Remember, we are always happy to find a time to discuss any concerns you may have.

Additional Program

Infinite Creations does offer additional programming such as studio events, community outreach and engagement, exams, a competition team, and a STEP Team (Student Teacher Education Program). If you have any questions, let us know! We would be happy to give you the inside scoop!

Class Cancellations

Infinite Creations reserves the right to cancel classes when necessary. If we must close unexpectedly (severe weather conditions, etc.) notifications will first be emailed and then posted on our Facebook/Instagram pages.

Registration Fee

An annual and non refundable registration fee of \$40.00/individual, or \$50.00/family + GST is charged at the time of registration for each season.

Payment Information

At the time of registration, you are required to select one of the following tuition payment methods:

1) Monthly

- You will be given a PAD (Pre Authorized Debit) agreement to sign and you will be required to provide a VOID cheque for an automatic withdrawal from your bank account for the first business day of each month until May.
- June will not be debited, as your deposit you pay up front takes place as your June payment.
- If you pay monthly, you must pay your registration fee and deposit (one month of tuition) at the time of registration. Your spot will not be held without this payment.

2) Full Year

- You may pay your tuition fees up front in one lump sum by debit, credit card, cash, or cheque.
- Payments can be made through the online parent portal (Visa or Mastercard only) or in person at the office.

Full Year Payments (con't)


- Please note that your June tuition is also your deposit, and is not refundable.

You will have seven days to choose and complete your payment method from the time of registration. If payment/documents are not received within those seven days, your registration will be removed without notice.

Withdrawal Policy

We are always so sad to see any of our dancers go, but we understand that things happen and plans change. To withdraw:

- Provide us with an email notice of the withdrawal (verbal withdrawals will not be taken) to dance@infinitecreationscalgary.com.
- All withdrawal notices must be given no later than the 15th of the month. Due to processing time, any withdrawals given past the 15th will forfeit your next month's tuition payment (your dancer is still welcome to come to class during that last month).
- Depending on your original method of tuition payment, you will either receive a refund for the remaining balance, or we will terminate the remainder your PAD payments. Either payment option is completely equal and will provide the same outcome.
- Partial tuition and/or missed classes will not be refunded.
- Withdrawals will not be processed after April 15.
- Deposit and Registration Fees are non refundable

Termination of Enrolment

In certain circumstances, when it is in the best interest of one or more students, it may be necessary for the studio director to terminate a student's enrolment. Every effort will be made to correct a problematic situation before terminating enrolment. Reasons for termination of enrolment include, but are not limited to:

1. Disruptive or dangerous behaviour by students or their parents
2. Abuse of or bullying other children, staff, or property
3. Inability of Infinite Creations Inc. to meet the student's needs

In such cases, refund of tuition will be considered and decided upon by the owners(s) and/or directors of Infinite Creations Inc.

Tuition Back Guarantee

We want our students to love what they do, so we are happy to offer a 30 day tuition back guarantee on all of our full year dance classes. The 30 day trial is valid starting on the first day the child is scheduled to start their class(es) with us and will run consecutively for thirty days from that date.

Should you wish to terminate your enrollment within this trial period, you must email the office (dance@infinitecreationscalgary.com) with your official withdrawal notice. You must submit your written notice within the 30 days in order to receive your fees back. Please note that we refund tuition only, your registration fee remains non refundable. Full tuition will not be refunded after the 30 day trial is complete. Any withdrawals received after the 30 days will be subject to our regular withdrawal policy.

Absences

Attendance is important, but we know things happen! Send us an email, or give us a call if your dancer will be missing class.



Studio Policies

Absences (con't)

Remember, dance is a physical activity that requires the body to be warmed up in order to execute movement safely. Late students will miss the proper warm up and/or barre and therefore are more susceptible to injury. Students who arrive more than 15 minutes late may be asked to observe class for reasons of personal safety.

Missed Classes (Ages 8 and Under)

Any child, who misses a class, will have the opportunity to make it up with another similar class within the schedule. Please note that some of our classes do not have the same level offered at a different time throughout the week, and thus we will do our best to recommend a similar class for a makeup.

Please check with the office to determine the best make up class and availability for your dancer. **Makeup classes are to be done on a temporary basis and cannot become habitual. Make up classes must be scheduled and approved through the office prior to your child's attendance.**

Missed Classes/Zoom Policy (Ages 9+)

For dancers aged 9 and up, a zoom class option is available when you are unable to attend in person. By this age, many of our classes do not have an alternative option in the schedule for a makeup class. If you wish to have your dancer participate online, an online class fee of \$8.00 + GST per zoom link/class will be charged and must be paid in order for links to be sent (with a maximum fee of \$16.00/day). This fee covers the associated costs with online options.

Illness Policy

We ask that all students adhere to the current AHS health and safety guidelines for attending our classes. More information can be found online through the [AHS website](#)

We ask that you please refrain from bringing your child to class if they have the following signs or symptoms of illness:

- Vomiting, fever, diarrhea, or a new or unexplained rash or cough
- Requiring greater care and attention than can be provided without compromising the care of the other children in the program
- Having or displaying any other illness or symptom that may pose a health risk to the staff or other children such as:

Conjunctivitis

Difficulty swallowing

Consistent complains of undiagnosed pain

Known or suspected communicable disease

Persistent green or discoloured discharge from the nose

Evidence of infection

Rapid or difficulty with breathing

Lethargy and abnormal tiredness and/or weakness

Excessive coughing and sneezing

If your child is required to be on antibiotics, we request that you keep them home until it has been 24 hours since the first dose was administered, and the child is no longer exhibiting signs/symptoms of their diagnosed illness.

Emergency Evacuation Policy

In the event of an Emergency Evacuation, the children will be taken to:

If our facility must be evacuated, the team members will follow our studio evacuation protocol. Once the premises has been cleared and the students/team members have safely reached the Emergency Assembly Point, parents will be contact via phone to come pick up their child.

Parking Lot Safety

Crow Square is a busy place! Please enter and exit the parking lot with extreme caution and remind your dancer(s) of proper parking lot safety. Remember, the middle stalls are all 3 hour parking, and the stalls that line the perimeter of the front are 30 minute. This parking lot is monitored regularly.

Social Media Policy

We get it, it's a social world out there! It's a great platform to connect, but here are some studio guidelines:

- We encourage parents to have discussions with their young dancers regarding safe practices and online safety.
- We strongly encourage parents to monitor their dancer's online accounts
- Dancers should never reveal their location publicly while at IC
- Everyone (dancers included) should refrain from posting content that includes other dancers without prior permission from them (and their parents)

Social Media Policy (con't)

- Please do not post any information that compromises Infinite Creations Inc. (personal information about directors, faculty, other students/families, along with any other information that be confidential in nature).
- We all have our own voice, so please do not claim or imply you're speaking on behalf of Infinite Creations on your social media platforms.
- Our community lifts one another up. Posting anything that could compromise the self-esteem of our dance family (the students at IC) is unacceptable.
- If you wish to post videos of class content or rehearsals (to be done only with teacher's permission), you may not post any choreography in its entirety. Infinite Creations Inc. owns the copyright to all choreography and work taught at the studio.
- Please respect the law at all times while posting anything on premises or studio related
- Positivity Please! We encourage you to use your social media platforms for positivity and refrain from posting negative comments about other studios, conventions, competitions, etc. Respect is critical!

General Policies

- The office and staff room are for members of the teaching & admin team only.
- We encourage dancers to bring water bottles into the studio, but please leave all other food and drink in the lobby area
- Children must be supervised at all times and are not free to run around the lobby or the classroom areas. Children are not permitted inside the dance studio rooms unless supervised by a staff member of Infinite Creations Inc.

General Policies (con't)

- We want the students to be focused in class - this is their creative outlet! Use of tech devices in the classrooms is discouraged and dancers are asked not to bring them into the studio.
- Respect for others (team members, other dance families, etc.) is expected and required while at IC. Leaders build one another up and encourage others! Concerns are for collaboration and we hope we can all work together! Inappropriate behaviour could result in dismissal from our program.
- We do not recruit or solicit students from other schools

Class Visitors

There are certain safety issues and legal responsibilities involved with having class visitors. This makes it very difficult for us to allow students to bring visitors into the classroom. We discourage students and parents from inviting siblings, friends or other relatives to their classes without prior permission from the studio director (with the exception of studio special events such as bring a friend week or parent viewing week).

Recital

Our Year End Showcase is one of the highlights for our dance season! In June, we give our dancers the chance to showcase their talents and hard work! Details regarding our showcase will be provided as they become available. **Please note that all extra costs associated with recital (costume, show tickets, etc.) are extra, and are not included in your monthly tuition.** Recital costume prices are based on many factors (exchange rate, duty, etc.) and often range anywhere from \$60.00 - \$125.00. These costumes are yours to keep. Recital Tickets are usually priced around \$25.00 + GST each

Recital Costumes

The teachers at Infinite Creations spend a lot of time determining costumes for each class. We do our best to ensure that they are age appropriate and appropriate for the class. Costumes may not include accessories, so please watch for extra notes regarding that aspect of the costuming process. A few important costume details:

- Costumes can take a while to arrive (up to five months in some cases) so orders are placed in December/January
- Costume manufacturers DO NOT accept cancellations or offer refunds; therefore, the school does not refund costume payments under any circumstances.
- Your costume will not be ordered until they are paid for in full
- Account balances must be paid before ordering and/or receiving your costume
- Late orders are subject to late fees and all additional surcharges, expenses and additional shipping fees that are associated with your order. On time delivery of late costume orders are not guaranteed in these situations.
- You are responsible for alterations (if any) to your costume upon its arrival.
